

Our Mother Church, through the Synodal Journey imparted by Pope Francis, is experiencing a true kairós in which our Order wishes to be an active participant by achieving the objectives of this Strategic Plan.

Indeed, this **Strategic Plan**, gathers the cry of hope of our entire Order that emerged from the last General Chapter. At this historical moment, our Camillian mission carries innumerable challenges and opportunities that require from all of us constant reflection, evangelical discernment and scientific-pastoral methodologies for the implementation of our vocation of witnessing to Christ the Good Samaritan. The goals of revitalization of our religious consecration and restructuring of our Order already planned in the Camillian Project continue to be clear horizon in the actuality of our lived experience.

Therefore, after an in-depth discussion with the Major Superiors of our Order at the annual gathering held in June 2023 and an integration of the useful suggestions, we are sending you the final draft of our **Strategic Plan 2023-2028**. Together with each of you we want to implement it and we hope that it will serve as a basis and inspiration for the elaboration or updating of the Strategic Plan of each Province and Delegation with the aim of accompanying, supporting, and strengthening the common faith in our Order towards a future of hope.

Introduction

We live in a highly complex, highly chaotic, interconnected and rapidly changing world characterized by plurality, interculturality and multiculturalism. This complexity, though appears negative, is undoubtedly a source of newness and endless new opportunities and challenges, if managed well. At this new juncture, we are called to learn how to live, adapting and acquiring the ability to cultivate appropriate flexibility, openness, intuitive thoughts, creative habits, dynamic approaches, new perspectives and new paradigms.

Therefore, this is definitely a new opportunity also for us Camillian religious who, living and reading the present, are called to create a new culture - synodal culture -, and therefore, a new operational style in our Order. This new approach requires our total commitment, great enthusiasm and intense passion. This time is a “Kairos”, a favourable time for change,

adaptation and the process of transformation of the entire Order. The inspirational foundations and principles of our charism remain unchanged: indeed, they should be renewed with “creative-dynamic fidelity”. It is no longer enough to write and speak: the time has come for a new praxis of Camillian life. “By their fruits you will know them” (Mt 7:16).

At this moment in history, our Camillian mission brings with it countless challenges that require constant reflection and discernment. One element that can help us is the introduction of a new professional style, which is not opposed to living the radicality of the Gospel, but helps us to concretize it in the “here” and “now” of our time.

In this context, we, Camillian religious, need a precise and specific orientation, a strategic plan that will guarantee fraternal unity, that will make us rediscover

hope and trust through the process of revitalization and restructuring of our Order. This theme - fraternal unity in the Order - was amply explicated and expressed in the last General Chapter (May 2022), with the slogan “More Order less Province”. This slogan expresses in a practical and pragmatic way the general desire of the members of our Order to strengthen the bond of fraternal unity in diversity and to increase the sense of belonging to the Order. As St. Paul states, we are one body and as such we must act in harmony (cf. 1 Cor12:13).

This new vision of the Order has already been widely concretized in several documents such as: the Camillian Project for a Creative and Faithful Life; the state of the Order presented by the outgoing General Council; the resolutions of the General Chapter of May 2022; and the reports of the Major Superiors of the Order. Currently, the Order has taken on a good number of common projects, made several decisions, but lacks a planning process, a timeline for implementation, a good periodic evaluation system, and a consistent and appropriate reprogramming process. In this regard, a strategic plan has been

developed to help us realize our dreams, turn our thinking into reality, and implement our vision.

The content of this strategic plan should help us better understand and live our charism in a meaningful, effective and fruitful way. It will strongly motivate us to live together with a sense of collective, collaborative, synodal consciousness and belonging. In other words, it is a plan that will help us manage well the treasure entrusted to us (cf. Mt 25:14-30; Mt 7:24-27).

The goal of this strategic plan is to begin a process of restructuring and revitalization of our Order by preserving our consecrated life and reinvigorating our religious. This strategic plan for our Order on the basis of the exhortations of our General Chapter (May 2022) and the recommendations of the Camillian Project which, in fact, explicitly give us the commitments we need to continue walking together in the sexennium 2023-2028, and we wish to turn it into a plan of action and commitments so that by 2028 the vision of “revitalization and restructuring” will be a reality within our Order.

We entrust all our plans and desires to St. Camillus, who accompanies us on our journey and invites us to do God's will in the implementation of this Strategic Plan as a visible sign of God's merciful love for his people. May the spirit of our Founder, St. Camillus and our Mother, Queen of the Ministers of the Infirm, be the sources of light that guide us and the strength to embrace the future with hope.
